TOWN OF BLACK EARTH, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Notice is hereby given that a special town meeting of the Town of Black Earth, Dane County, Wisconsin, will be held in the town at 1116 Mills St. Black Earth, WI, On the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, immediately following the completion of the Public Hearing on the proposed 2019 budget which begins at 6:00pm for the following purposes:

1. To establish the compensation for elected town officers pursuant to s.60.10(1)(b)1, Wis. Stat. (Any approved changes will not become effective until the start of the new terms in April 2019 for the elected in odd number years)
2. To consider the adoption of a resolution by the town meeting endorsing a town board resolution which proposes that the town levy exceed the state allowable levy limit under s.66.0602 of Wis. Statutes, specifically a proposed tax levy which would exceed the allowable town tax levy for 2018 by 15.8 percent which would be a dollar increase of \$ 38,952.00
3. To authorize the use of unused levy capacity from the prior year as determined by the department of revenue (in Section B of the Municipal Levy Limit Worksheet) and as approved by the town board via resolution No. 2018-3budget adopted pursuant to s.66.0602(3)(f)3c, Wis. Statutes.
4. To approve the 2018 total town tax levy to be collected in 2019 pursuant to s.60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes.
