VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT

Town of Black Earth Presidential Preference Primary & Spring Election April 7, 2020

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>April 7</u>, <u>2020</u> for the Presidential Preference Primary & Spring Election may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. Citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on election day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 10 days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

To request an absentee ballot, please contact your municipal clerk.

Your absentee ballot request must be in writing, whether it be by email, letter, filling out the absentee ballot request form, or online at MyVote.wi.gov. Your written request must list your name, voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and the date of the election(s) you are requesting your ballot for. You must also provide your photo ID.

TO RECEIVE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL:

The deadline for making application to vote absentee by mail is 5:00 PM on the fifth day before the election: **Thursday, April 2, 2020**.

Note: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk.

VOTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN-PERSON

You may also request and vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office during the specified hours or by appointment. You must also provide your Photo ID.

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is: WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18, 2020.

The last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is: FRIDAY, APRIL 3, 2020.

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election.

The municipal clerk will deliver all voted ballots returned on or before Election Day to the proper polling place *before* the polls close on April 7, 2020. Any ballots received after the polls close at 8:00 PM will not be counted.
