An announcement from PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON & DANE COUNTY:

The COVID test site at Alliant Energy Center is closed on Sundays and Mondays. It opens at noon on Tuesdays. In previous weeks, we have had a line before we've even opened for the day on Tuesdays. If you're coming to get tested, we suggest you avoid this time.

If you attended a gathering this weekend and are concerned you may have been exposed, getting tested today or tomorrow is too

early. You most likely won't have built up enough virus in your body to be detected by a test yet. Please wait 3-5 days after an exposure to get tested, unless you have symptoms.

As a reminder, we recommend testing for:

- ☞ People who have had close contact (within 6 feet for about 15 minutes) with someone who tested positive for COVID.
- ☞ People with COVID symptoms.
- ☞ People who have regular exposure to a large number of people (like people who work in grocery stores)
- ☞ People who work closely with high-risk populations (like healthcare workers).
